- The above financial information did not include the following transfer, the Village will transfer all the infrastructure funds collected and late payment penalties to the waterworks reserve fund for a total transfer of – \$37,924.00
- In 2022 the Village was able to replace the waterline at the 300 Block of Main Street and purchase two sewage pumps at the lift station.
- Waterworks Reserve Fund for the end of 2022 is a Deficit of \$5569.93
- the 2022 waterworks assessment –see attached water compliance inspection report for 2022
- Capital Plans in place and related sources of funding for the projects
 - The Village of Dysart has no Capital Investment plans for 2023.
- Please note that the cost of waterworks expenditures above includes administration costs. A specific breakdown of these costs can be viewed at the Village Office.
- In 2022 waterworks posted a surplus of \$32,401.83 and this money includes the infrastructure fees collected and the Canada Community Building Fund (Gas Tax Grant) and the applicable portions will be allocated to the infrastructure reserve accounts.
- When the Water and Sewer function applies a transfer to the Infrastructure Reserve account, the Water and Sewer function posted a **deficit** of \$5,522.17 Using these figures for 2023 – the Water and Sewer function is forecasted to post a \$4,475.00 deficit.
